This Privacy Policy explains how Atreides Industries collects, uses, stores, and shares personal data when you visit our website, contact us, or engage with us in a business capacity.

This policy is intended to meet the requirements of UK data protection law, including the UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018.

1. Who we are

Atreides Industries ("we", "us", "our") is a UK-based company located in Glasgow, United Kingdom.

2. Personal data we collect

- Enquiry and correspondence data: name, email address, organisation, role/title, and the content of messages you send us.
- Business relationship data: details required to manage supplier/partner relationships (e.g., procurement, billing contacts, meeting notes).
- Website technical data: IP address, browser/user-agent data, timestamps, and other log data used to operate and secure the site.
- Recruitment data (if applicable): information you choose to provide (e.g., CV, employment history).

3. How we use personal data

- To respond to enquiries and provide requested information.
- To manage contracts and business relationships with partners, suppliers, and customers.
- To protect our systems and prevent fraud or misuse.
- To meet legal and regulatory obligations and to establish, exercise, or defend legal claims.
- To improve our website and user experience (where applicable).

4. Lawful bases

We process personal data where we have a lawful basis, including: legitimate interests, contract, legal obligation, and (where required) consent.

5. Sharing and processors

We do not sell personal data. We may share personal data with trusted service providers that support our operations (e.g., hosting, communications, IT support) and with professional



advisers where necessary. Providers are required to apply appropriate confidentiality and security measures.

6. International transfers

Where personal data is processed outside the UK, we implement appropriate safeguards consistent with applicable data protection requirements.

7. Retention

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary for the purposes described above, taking into account legal, regulatory, and contractual obligations.

8. Your rights

Subject to applicable law, you may have rights to access, rectification, erasure, restriction, objection, and data portability. You may also lodge a complaint with the UK Information Commissioner's Office (ICO).
